


North Entrance - 198 Gaston Street NE, Aiken, SC 29801 (physical address)

I-20 to SC Exit 22 US Hwy 1. Go towards Aiken. Follow to 7-8 miles until in Aiken. At second light in town, go left on 118 (Sunoco Gas on left). At first light go right onto Beaufort Street. Go through one light. Before second light, go left on Barnwell Avenue.

At stop cross over dirt road onto gravel driveway. Horse show on left. To access Barns 2 & 3, use our North entrance at Willow Run Road, one block North from Barnwell. Tip: Do Not Use Mapquest.

HUNTER DIVISION PRIZE MONEY

1st - 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 15%, 4th 15%, 5th 10%, 6th 8%

HUNTER OVER FENCES

To be shown over approximately eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE CLASS

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at the discretion of the judge, but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales are not permitted. Green and non-rated hunter sections will not be asked to gallop.

MODEL CLASS

To be shown at a walk and trot on the line; to be judged on conformation, way of moving and soundness.

HUNTER CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION

To be awarded to two of the four horses scoring the most points over fences, in addition, only these will receive full points for ribbons won under saddle and half points for ribbons won in the model.

COURSES

Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunting fields such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants.

MEASUREMENT CARDS - PONY HUNTER

The person presenting any animal to be shown in a Hunter Pony class must be in possession of (a) a measurement card issued by the USEF; (b) a certified card applied for prior to Dec. 1, 1987; or (c) a copy of a valid measurement form, and same must be presented to the horse show secretary. Numbers WILL NOT be issued before the above requirements have been complied with. Time and place of measurement will be announced for those requiring measurement.

MEASUREMENT CARDS - JUNIOR HUNTER

All horses showing in the Junior Hunter division must be in possession of a USEF measurement card or a copy of a valid measurement form, and same must be presented to the horse show secretary.

FORMAL ATTIRE - HUNTERS & EQUITATION

Hunt coat; white shirt with white stock, tie or choker; white, buff or canary breeches; protective headgear. Riders must wear protective headgear in accordance with USEF rules. NO EXCEPTIONS.

USEF CONDITIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

S.C. EQUINE LIABILITY LAW

Jumper Class Specifications

POLING AND OFFSETS

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited for all horses competing. Any rider, trainer, groom, or any other person who is in violation of the rules set forth above will be fined \$500 for each incident and may be suspended from further competition for the duration of the scheduled competition starting from the time of the incident. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offsets rules is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for the duration of the scheduled competition. All entry fees for the classes entered during the suspended period of the horse in question will be forfeited.

DECLARATIONS

Declarations must be made on the appropriate form in the show office the day before the class is to be held by 4 pm or one hour after the last Jumper class, whichever is later. Untimely declarations will be subject to the post entry penalty and may require the horse to jump first in the order of go.

45 SECOND CLOCK

Will be in effect in all jumper classes.

ADD BACK JUMPERS

Paid back to top six places. \$10 per entry applied to add back, breakdown as follows: 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%. If there are less than six horses in a class, the entry fee drops to \$30 with no prize money paid back.

TIME ALLOWED

The time allowed is based on minimum of 382 yards per minute for all sections.

Courses

Courses may consist of any combination of the following: brush, gates, oxers, post and rails, water, liverpool, ditch, wall, banks, panels, or coops.

TIES

All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided by time, unless otherwise stated.

OPEN JUMPER SECTIONS

Any horse, regardless of winnings, is eligible to enter.

ORDERS OF GO

In order for us to schedule the entire day, your entries will need to be in the show office by 5 pm the day prior to our show day. We will make a time schedule plan based on the class numbers and multiple riders at that time. The daily agenda will be posted at the Show office and online no later than 8pm the day before you show. You will need to check-in with your starter early in the day to sign up in the order of go.

NOMINATING FEE - \$175

All horses showing in the GP, Welcome, Junior/Amateur Owner, High Children's/Adult, 1.25m, 1.30m, 1.35m, 1.40m classes/division must be nominated and pay the nominating fee of \$175 by the closing date of the show. Once a horse is nominated, the nominating fee is NOT refundable.

THE EMERSON BURR HORSEMANSHIP GRANT

The Emerson Burr Horsemanship Grant will be awarded to the highest scoring participant of each of these four age groups: 8 and under; 9-11; 12-14; and 15-17. Each winner at the zone level receives a \$100 grant to use towards educational related expenses.

Riders competing in pony classes are eligible to participate in this program. Each participant will take a short, multiple choice test on horsemanship, which contains no more than 20 questions and respond to a short essay question. A winner will be selected from each age group based on the results. Grant information forms received by winners must be returned to USEF by November 15.



The Emerson Burr Grant will also be offered on a National Level during USEF Pony Finals presented by Collecting Gaits Farm. So start sharpening your horsemanship knowledge! Check with the horse show office to see how you can participate!



Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

WARNING: HIGHFIELDS EVENT CENTER, PROGRESSIVE SHOW JUMPING, IT'S MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, OWNERS, OFFICIALS, AND EMPLOYEES WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR TO AN EXHIBITOR, SPECTATOR, GUEST, RIDER, GROOM, ATTENDANT OR OTHER EMPLOYEE, ANIMAL, VEHICLE, OR EQUIPMENT AT THE SHOW. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8.00 USEF fee. (Total \$23.00 USEF Fee). Each horse entered will also be required to pay the USHJA Zone Support fee of \$7.00.

While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication, USEF, Highfields Event Center, Progressive Show Jumping and its management and/employees assume no liability to anyone for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted upon their acceptance, and otherwise in accordance with USEF rules.

Credentials: ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS (MEASUREMENT CARD OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATION) TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Kindly send a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will be charged a \$45.00/\$3.00 non-refundable show pass fee. Amateur exhibitors not able to present valid Amateur Credentials will be required to join the Federation. Only a parent will be exempt from the Federation non-member fee if signing as coach for his/her minor child.





Horse Registrations: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Proof of registration must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers can be released. To be eligible for National, Regional or Zone Horse of the Year Awards, and to enter a USEF Computer Ranking List Class horses must also be registered with the USEF. Exception for USEF Computer Ranking List: Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation need not have USEF Registration.

Coggins Test: South Carolina state law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA certificate dated within one year.

Entries: The closing date for entries for March Madness I & II is February 22nd, 2021. After this date stall fees are non-refundable. A \$50 late fee will apply for all entries not received by these dates. Entries should be made at horseshowsonline.com. Numbers WILL NOT be issued without a SIGNED OPEN CHECK or CREDIT CARD INFORMATION lodged with the Horse Show Secretary. A \$46 Office/Service Fee will be charged to each horse to cover adds/scratches, office services, etc. Please note; a \$50 fee will be charged for non-negotiable checks/or declined credit card. The entry form for each show must include the following:

-Horse name and complete description;

- •All classes or divisions entered;
- •All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting;
- Organization membership numbers;
- •Social Security or Federal ID number of owner or prize money alternate payee.

Stalls: Permanent 10 X 12 stalls of wood/metal construction with doors and matted floor or portable stabling on grass are available during the event at a cost of \$225 per horse/pony. Stalls will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Feed and Bedding: Feed and Bedding orders are to be placed through psishows87@gmail.com.

Motor Homes: Camper spot reservations are to be made through psishows87@gmail.com

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts: Under South Carolina State Laws and USEF rules, unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles — ATVs, motorcycles, golf carts, etc., on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. See USEF GR 301.

Minor Exhibitors: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.





Protective Headgear: Protective head gear, properly secured, must be worn BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for all riders must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness per USEF rules.

Ticketed Warm-Up: Tickets may be purchased in the Horse Show Office and are good for one Round of eight jumps. \$35 charge per ticket.

Non-Showing Horses: All non-showing horses must complete an entry blank and be assigned a back number. A \$50 fee will be assessed to any horse not entered in any classes.

Prize Money: The owner of any horse/pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded MUST provide a social security number or Federal ID number on the entry form. Prize money will be credited to your show account. Any overages will be mailed within 30 days of check-out. In the event of unauthorized redeeming of a check, Progressive Show Jumping, will provide check copies to exhibitors and will be held harmless from the collection process.

Dogs: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301. Failure to maintain your dog, under control, as defined here, will result in a \$100 fine assessed to the owner. In addition, pursuant to facility regulations, loose dogs will be removed by animal control, from the show grounds, at the owner's expense and impounded.

Animal Welfare: We require that all horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion and should never be subject to mistreatment. Owners, trainers, riders and grooms, or their agents must use reasonable care in the handling and treatment of their horses whether owned or placed in their care for competition or for any other purpose. At all times, while the horse is on the show grounds, we will provide for the continuous well-being of the horse by vigorously enforcing the rules of the USEF which pertain to the welfare of the horse. USEF rules defining policy regarding abuse and use of whips will be strictly enforced. No poling, use of bamboo off-set or excessive use of the whip will be tolerated. The well being of the horse must be considered above the demands of the breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors or officials. Violators may be subject to penalties pursuant to USEF rules. In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

Electrical/Fire Regulations: All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

Parking: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or off-load. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNERS EXPENSE

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
