

NCHJA Medal Rule Changes to take effect June 1, 2022.

All A and C Medal Classes 3 to complete to fill for points to count. Delete the 4 to fill.

A Show Medal Finals:

All Finals (except Pony Medal Finals) to be shown over an equitation finals type course of at least 10 fences. All without major errors will return for a flat phase. Flat phase to be conducted in groups of no more than 12. The top 10 will return to jump a second round. Additional testing at the judge's discretion. Ribbons to tenth place. Finals must use a USEF licensed course designer.

C Show Medals:

Rider may only compete in one medal per competition and can only show in one Final.

Children's Medal – Open to junior members of the NCHJA. To be shown over an equitation type course of at least eight fences 2'9" in height with at least 2 USEF tests included as part of the course. A combination is recommended.

Adult Medal – Open to amateur members of the NCHJA. To be shown over an equitation type course of at least eight fences 2'9" in height with at least 2 USEF tests included as part of the course. A combination is recommended.

Pony Medal – Open to junior members of the NCHJA. To be shown over an equitation type course of at least eight fences with at least 2 USEF tests included as part of the course (No combinations). Small ponies jump 2', Medium ponies jump 2'3" and Large ponies jump 2'6".

Adding: Low Child/Adult Medal – Open to junior and amateur members of the NCHJA who in the last 10 years have never won any medal, equitation, hunter or jumper class with fences 3' or higher. In addition, any rider who has competed in any class in the last 10 years with fences 3'3" or higher is not eligible to compete in this class. To be shown over an equitation course of at least eight fences 2'6" in height (n combinations) with at least 2 USEF tests included as part of the course. This medal may be offered split between Children's and Adults.
